All masks are a barrier to communication, but clear masks can help. Consider the <u>Americans</u> with <u>Disabilities Act Frequently Asked Questions</u> and the Effective Communication document available at WA Hands & Voices when advocating for transparent mask use. You may want to try several masks and see what works for you.

Guidance on Cloth Face Coverings from the Washington State Department of Health COVID-

19 is spreading in Washington state. Currently, there are three face cover orders in place: for Employers and Workers, for the Public and for Businesses. People with COVID-19 can spread the virus even when they don't have symptoms or know that they are sick. The Washington State Department of Health requires you to wear a cloth face covering in public when you cannot stay six feet (or two meters) away from others. You must wear a face covering in indoor public settings like the grocery store, pharmacy, hardware store, health clinic, and other locations. You should also wear a face covering outside if you cannot keep six feet (or two meters) away from other people at all times https://www.doh.wa.gov/Portals/1/Documents/1600/coronavirus/ClothFacemasks.pdf
