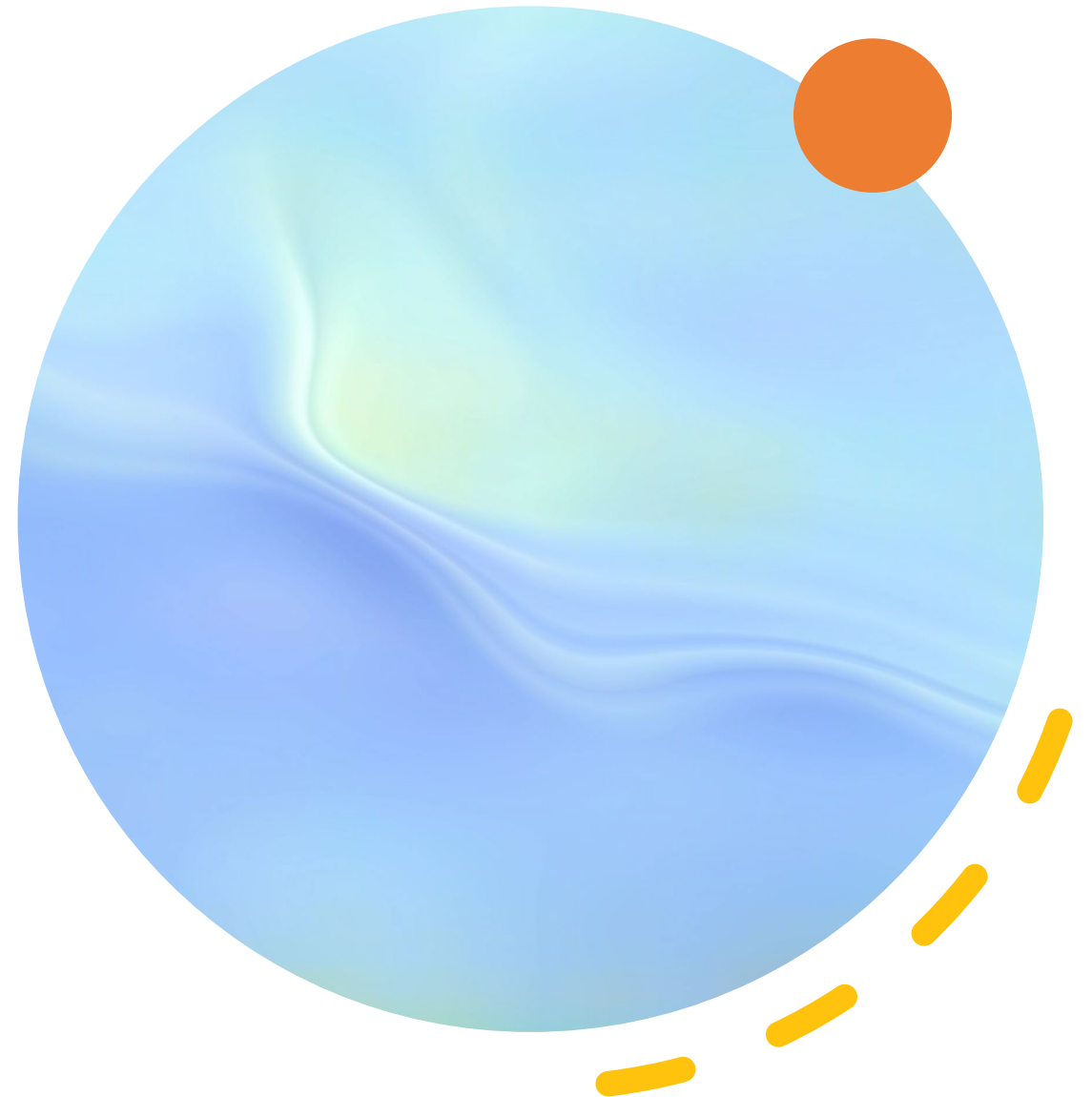

Kindergarten- 30 min to 1 hour

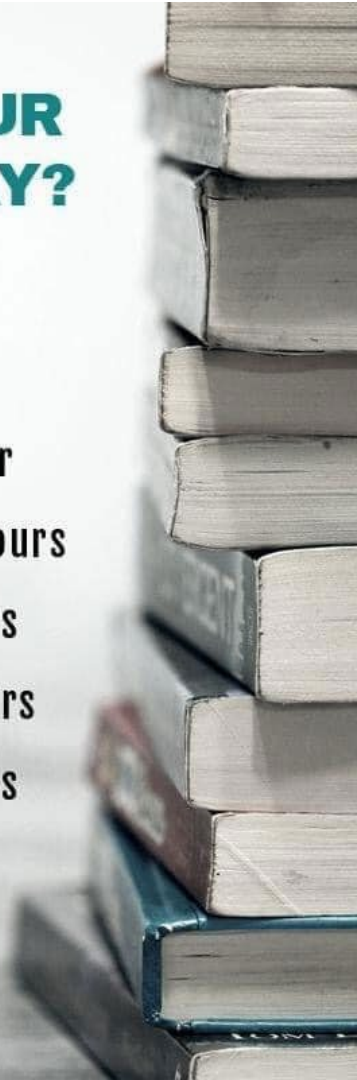
1st to 2nd Grade- 45 min to 1.5 hours

3rd to 4th Grade- 1.5 to 3 hours

5th to 6th Grade- 2.5 to 3.5 hours

7th to 8th grade- 3 to 4.5 hours

High School- 3.5 to 6 hours


